ANTICIPATED Band Fees and Expenses

Here's what you can budget for.

THESE WILL BE FINALIZED AT OUR JUNE EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETING. THE INFORMATION WILL BE COMMUNICATED THROUGH BAND APP.

- Band Fees \$400 for all students
- Flag / Dance Uniform \$350 All Members (Due before June 1)
- Band Shoes (winds/percussion) \$40
- Gloves (winds) \$5
- Metronome/Tuner (winds) \$35
- Concert Dress (Female winds/percussion) \$65
 - Male wind and percussion will need to purchase a tuxedo on their own
- Flag Bag w/practice flag (flag line) \$50
- Food Card \$30
- Instrument rental \$75
 - This would include bass clarinets, bari saxes, French horns, baritones, tubas, mellophones, marching baritones, sousaphones, and all percussion



Summer Sponsorship Drive

We've got an idea...

- We are asking all students to raise \$100 through this new program.
- It is a student share fundraiser (and replaces our banner sales)
- There are an assortment of levels to participate
 - Starts at \$100 with a thank you in our concert programs and on our website
 - Goes to \$10,000 with their company logo placed on our new trailer, the opportunity to conduct the band, and have the band perform for your company
- Students earn \$100 for every sponsorship at the \$500 level or higher

Other Fundraising

Sharkettes – TBA

• Student share fundraiser - \$25 to student accounts for each girls signed up by the student.

Non-Varsity Football Concession

- Student share \$25 credit per event
- Parent must work 1 varsity football game in concessions to qualify or work 25+ hours for varsity football game in another capacity.

Uniform Fitting

Everyone does this!!!

- At uniform fitting there are a number of things you will need to accomplish.
 - · All winds and percussion will get fitted for their uniform
 - All students will:
 - Check paperwork for clearance
 - Receive their band shirt
 - Purchase any uniform accessories students need (band shoes, gloves, tuners, extra tights)
 - Pay their band fee (flag/dance will pay their uniform fee May 19 or before June 1)

School schedule

Now is where we teach about time management.

Once school starts on August 10, we begin our normal rehearsal schedule for marching band

- Full Marching Band Practices Tuesday and Thursday Nights 6:00-8:15pm
- Sectionals (throughout marching season)
 - Flutes, Clarinets, Saxes, and Front Ensemble Tuesday 2:30-4:00pm
 - Trumpets, Horns, Trombones, Baritones, Tubas, and All Percussion Thursdays 2:30-4:00pm
- Marching Band Performance Dates
 - Saturday practices August 12, September 9, and October 7
 - 1st Football Game August 18 @ Naples HS



Other marching band events

 - Marching Band Music Performance Assessment October 28
- Optional Performances (Costs will apply)
 - Disney TBA
 - We have been approved by Disney we are just waiting on a date confirmation. We are expecting a November/December Performance
 - Universal Studios TBA
 - We have been approved by Universal Studios and are just waiting on a date confirmation. We are expecting an October/November Performance

Concert Band

Wait. There's more?

- After football season, we refocus on performing inside. Performances include:
 - PRISM Late November
 - FMEA All-State Bands Early January
 - CCPS Honor Band Late January
 - FBA Performance Assessments Both District and State Levels
 - Jazz Band Early February and Early March
 - Solo and Ensemble Assessment Early February and Early March
 - Concert Music Early March and Late April
 - Percussion Recital Spring
 - Flag / Dance Recital Spring
 - Spring Concert for All Concert Bands

Concert Band Rehearsals

Wait. There's more?

- Our three concert ensembles meet after-school once-a-week starting in January
 - Concert Band (All freshmen winds and percussion) Tuesdays 5:00-6:30pm
 - Wind Ensemble (assigned winds and percussion) Tuesdays 2:30-4:30pm
- Varsity Flag Line will meet Thursdays from 6:30-8:00pm starting in November.
- Varsity Dance Line will meet Thursdays from 4:30-6:00pm starting in November.

These rehearsals continue until the end of the school year.

Concert Dress

All Winds and Percussion

- All students enrolled as a wind or percussion student must own the required concert band uniform.
 - Men Black Tuxedo provided by the student in full
 - Women Specific black dress ordered through the boosters (\$65).
 These dresses are unhemmed. Alterations are the responsibility of the student.

Auditioned Band Opportunities

CCPS Honor Band

- Auditions
 - Auditions are based on the lyrical All-State Audition music as well as All-State Scales performed in less than 3 minutes
 - Music is available now. Auditions will be held on November 28.

FMEA All-State Bands

- Auditions
 - Music is available now. Auditions will be held on September 23.
 - The event is held in early January.

Volunteering

How do I volunteer?

- If you are a district volunteer already, you will need to update your profile to include GCHS.
- If you have applied in the last 7 days, you are good. If not, you will need to go in and refresh your application as it will expire on June 30.
